

Year 1 – The World with Brown Rabbit

Word	Definition	Image
town (urban)	A place where people live and work. It is bigger than a village and smaller than a city.	
countryside (rural)	Land which is not in towns or cities. The countryside often has lots of farmland and woodland.	
city (urban)	A large and important town, where many people live and work.	
coast	The place where the land joins the sea.	
beach	A place on the coast where the sea washes over the land. Often sandy or with pebbles	
shop	A building people go to, to buy things.	
farm	An area of land used for raising animals and growing crops.	
season	Parts of the year with distinct weather patterns. In the UK – spring, summer, autumn, winter	
weather	The conditions of the earth's atmosphere. It includes temperature, wind and rainfall.	
office	A place where business work is done.	
factory	A building where people make things using machines.	
aerial	From the sky, such as an aerial photograph, like Google Earth	

About the world:

- There are 4 seasons in the UK. In spring it is often rainy and temperature begins to get warmer. In summer the sun is much stronger, the temp is warming than any other season. In autumn the weather turns chilly and windier and there is often rain. In the winter it is often cold and frosty. It has to be freezing cold to snow.
- Many countries have rural and urban areas – Urban areas are towns and cities, where lots of people live. Rural areas are in the countryside, where smaller groups of people live.
- The UK is made up of four countries - England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
- The capital city of England is London. The national flower is a rose.
- The capital city of Scotland is Edinburgh. The national flower is a thistle.
- The capital city of Wales is Cardiff. The national flower is a daffodil.
- The capital city of Northern Ireland is Belfast. The national flower is a shamrock.
- Rural and urban areas look different, depending on where they are in the world. For example, Lahore, Pakistan in Asia and New York in North America are very different
- We will look at how Lahore has different weather, seasons, buildings and animals from Nottingham.
- There are different ways of representing information about localities. An aerial photograph taken from the sky can help identify landmarks.
- Maps are drawn in a simplified way, with written labels. A map can show us where things are and which way to go. Different maps are used for different purposes
