Theme	Staying safe 5 – In this lesson you will be learning about how to stay safe when you are playing outside. After you have watched the video, try to make a model of a safe space to play. In the video she shows you one made with playdough. If you do not have playdough at home you could make your model from other bits of clean recycling such as boxes and pots (you might need an adult to help you cut these things) or you could make your model with lego.
