English	<p>Little Red Hen 6 – Today you will be thinking about “recycling” rhymes and stories and turning them into new ones. First you will recycle a nurse rhyme. Phonics	<p>Phase 2 phonics 6 – Miss Holly will teach you how to write the letters with correct letter formation. Watch Miss Holly then have a go at writing the letters yourself. You can write them a big or as small as you like. Maths	<p>Number 5 lesson 6 – Join in with Mrs Bowen to sing “5 little monkeys”. Then Join in With Mrs Bowen to do some “body maths” – doing 5 of each of the actions – count carefully! Theme	<p>People who help us 1 – In this video you will learn what it means to have a job. Watch the video and join in when you are asked to.
