<p>Story reading: I Spy Halloween</p> <p>I spy with my little eye Halloween features.</p>  <p>Construction</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Share the book with the children on the iPad/power point presentation.</li> <li>• Talk about Halloween and why do we celebrate it.</li> <li>• Talk about the emotions during Halloween i.e fear, excitement...</li> <li>• The children will be given each in their tray the previous night a sheet of Halloween features images, then will be asked to spot and colour any picture related to Halloween.</li> <li>• Each child will receive in their individual tray a small amount of construction set for the whole week then put in quarantine / soap washed.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Acknowledge the feelings.</li> <li>• Being brave and positive lead you far.</li> <li>• Hope and inspiration help to fight the fear and loneliness.</li> <li>• Understand the importance of social interaction.</li> <li>• Learn about the life under the water and the animals that live in.</li> <li>• Understand the world and improve their creativity.</li> <li>• Have fun.</li> <li>• Develop friendship.</li> </ul>
<p>Skelton coton budds making.</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The children will make their own cotton bud Skelton using their imagination.</li> <li>• Cutting, gluing, designing and feeling will be part of this activity.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bilateral coordination skills (two handed coordination).</li> <li>• Visual motor skills (eye- hand coordination).</li> <li>• Focus and attention.</li> <li>• Strengthens hand muscles.</li> <li>• <b>Symmetry</b></li> </ul>

<p>Play dough with Halloween features.</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The children will be given an individual portion of black play dough in their small zipped folder, googly eyes and other resources to make their own Halloween bat and a picture will be taken for internal display.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To act out ideas from real life.</li> <li>Enhance their language and their imagination.</li> <li>Socialising in a positive way and sharing.</li> </ul>
