Car parking safety at start and end of day

Please **DO NOT park in front of or reverse in front of school gates**. It is extremely dangerous as children are crossing the roads in front of school. It would be absolutely awful if one of our Dunkirk children were hit by a parents car! We have contacted the Local Authority parking enforcement team who can issue warning/fines for dangerous parking etc for spot checks outside both campuses.

Highfields families please **DO NOT drive** into the community centre car park to drop your child off or turn around. We do not have permission to use their car park for any vehicle drop-offs in the morning. Our agreement with the community centre is only for the children to line-up at the gate. Thank you to those families on bike who walk through the car park.

Coughs in school

As outlined in our risk assessment if a child demonstrates a new or continuous cough then we send the child home for a test and to isolate.

-If a child tests negative then the child can come back to school. The child may still be coughing but government and NHS guidelines are that it is a different cough and not covid. The child stays in school.

-A child may have tested positive and after 10 days isolation come back to school. They are no longer infectious but they may still have the same cough for weeks afterwards. The child stays in school.
